HOLE 5 – BOB GORINSKI



In January of 2020, Bob Gorinski was diagnosed with stage III Cancer. Bob was a husband to wife Amy, and the amazing father to 5 children. Prior to Bob's diagnosis, he was an extremely talented physical therapist. He trained many local high level athletes. Those athletes went on to play at the collegiate and even pro level. His physical and athletic abilities were unmatched by most of us that knew him. Bob was one of those humans we all agree we should strive to emulate ourselves.

Unfortunately, cancer does not care who you are, what kind of shape you are in, how great of a human, husband or father you are. Cancer, unexpected and without warning, entered the Gorinski family's lives. Bob immediately received treatments. His positive nature and inner strength, humor and infectious attitude, helped him fight the good fight.

Bob battled until July of 2021, when cancer took his life. In his passing he left a tremendous void in so many lives, but his memory and spirit live on through his wife and children

HOLE 14 – GUNNAR MIKACH

At Gunnar's 1-year checkup he was very pale. A blood test was ordered and several of Gunnar's levels were of concern to his doctors. It was believed he may have an internal bleed somewhere causing these discrepancies and/or gastro-intestinal issues. All subsequent tests and further attempts at a definitive diagnosis came back negative.

His parents spent over a year going back and forth to different doctors and hospitals until finally ending up at St. Jude's.

With no definitive diagnosis but continued medical issues, Gunnar began getting blood transfusions. The issues progressed and at only 2 years old, he had to receive a port in his chest as his veins were collapsing in his hands.

After going weekly for infusions at St. Jude's for over a year, they were only able to determine that Gunnar's body simply does not make, nor store the amount of iron needed to make blood for such a young growing boy. On top of this, Gunnar was diagnosed with Neutropenia as his neutrophil levels were extremely low without any reason or cause.

After another year passed and still no true diagnosis, St. Jude's recommended Gunnar to a genetic specialist at the Boston Clinic Medical Center. The hope was Boston Clinic would accept Gunnar's unusual and undiagnosed case.

The Boston Clinic accepted Gunnar's unusual case and is doing a full genetic screening as it seems that he might be the "first" to have whatever this genetic disorder is based on his symptoms and conditions.

They are hoping to get a definite answer one day from the genetic study.

Gunnar's parents must pay the first \$10,000 cash every year before insurance will pick up the rest of the treatments. Keystone Lodge 41 would like to help Gunnar and his family cover some of the ever-continuous costs of his treatments. Your donations at hole 14 are greatly appreciated.
